The advertisement for the post of Assistant Professor in 19 nos. of Super Speciality disciplines in WBMES has been published on 21st April, 2022 vide No. R/AP(Super Sp.)/24/2022 dated 19.04.2022. In the above mentioned Advertisement the experience of the candidates as "Senior Resident in the concerned subject in a recognised/ permitted Medical College" is mentioned as Essential experience.

Attention is drawn to the following facts regarding the essential experience stated in the above mentioned advertisement:

- As per NMC rules February, 2022 the DM/MCh students shall be designated as Senior Resident in the concerned subject for appointment as Faculty in Super Speciality discipline.
- The candidates who have passed DM/MCh in the concerned subject **will be considered as Senior Resident for the above mentioned post.**
- The candidates who are still pursuing the DM/MCh course **will not be** considered as Senior Resident.
- The candidates are requested to upload their final mark sheet of DM/MCh qualification in the space of Essential experience as "**Senior Resident in the concerned Subject in a recognised/ permitted Medical College [Relevant documents to be attached]**".
- Whereas this is once again restated that the candidates **also has to** upload all years' including supplementary mark sheets of their respective DM/MCh qualification in the space of Essential Qualification as "**Post-Doctoral qualification DM/MCh/DNB equated to DM/MCh –(for disciplines under the Super Specialities Group) in terms of Schedule-1 in the concerned Subject.**"
